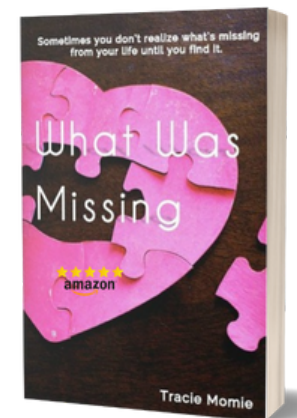
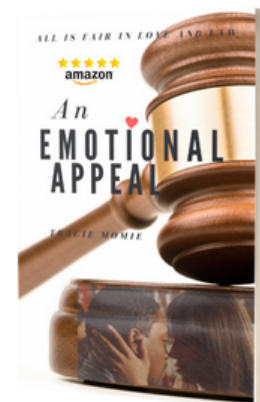

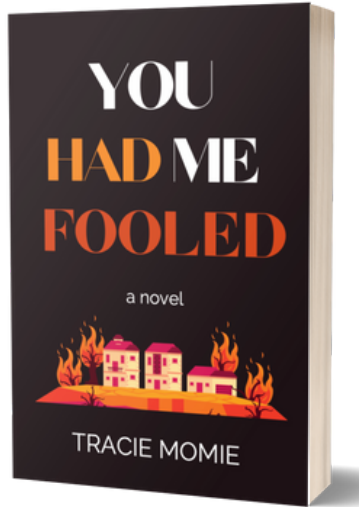

Here You Come Again

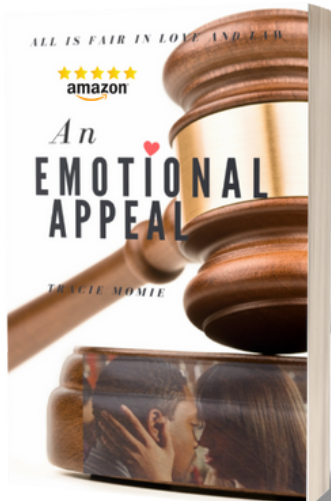

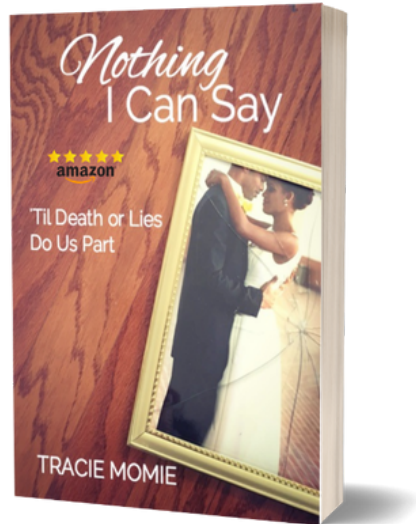

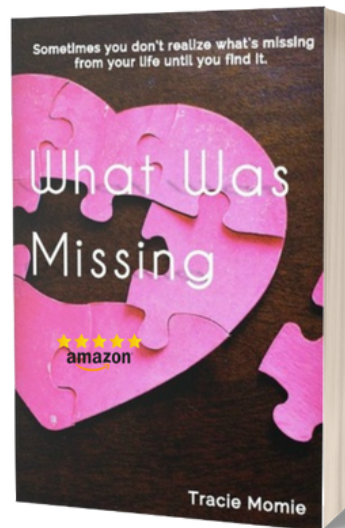
Nothing I Can Say

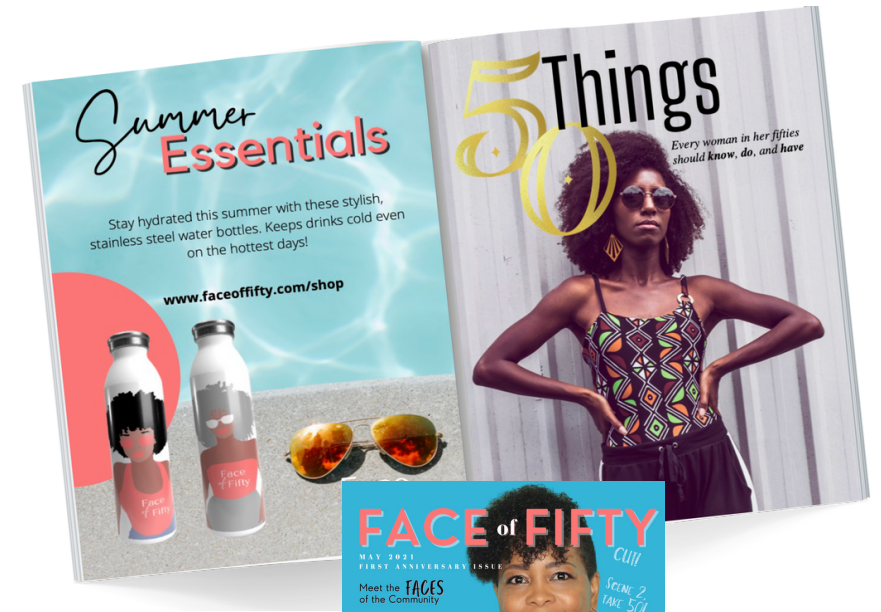
